1 in 2 Families
struggle to afford

No Social Safety Net
Government programs such as
SNAP, WIC (Nutritional
Program) and Medicaid do
not cover diapers

Diapers Cost \$80-\$100 per month
1 in 4 families experiencing diaper need
have missed an average of 5 days of
work a month which is a \$612 loss of
income in Connecticut

**Diaper Need Intersects with

28% skipped meals
35% cut back on food
and groceries
